



Here's a look at the six fabulous homes on the 2015 Westover Hills Home Tour, on Sunday, April 26, from noon to 5 p.m.

- **5315 Riverside Drive.** This beautiful white brick house sits on a hillside overlooking the river at the corner of New Kent Rd. You may have seen it on the previous tour, but it's worthy of another peek to see the fabulous new kitchen and an equally fabulous new swimming pool. The home dates back to 1928 and has five sets of French doors. The owners have decorated the interior in soft shades of grays, blues, and silver with lots of white trim. It is a stunning, elegant home.
- **5208 Riverside Drive.** In 2013, the traditional rancher on this lot was torn down to make room for this exciting ultra-contemporary home. The environmentally friendly home features a "run off" rain garden in front and an exterior built to be as close to "no maintenance" as possible. The interior presents a cool, clean and polished look, with white quartz counter tops, white cabinets, and a backsplash of ice-blue painted glass. The new home was built on the original house's footprint, so it was classified as "renovation" rather than "new construction." And you should see the view of the river!
- **5005 Riverside Drive.** This contemporary house was on the previous tour while it was still under construction. Nestled in the trees in a secluded landscape off Riverside, it is simply a "show place." The views through the walls of windows are breathtaking, especially from the deck off the master bedroom. Be sure to notice the tree house designed by a local architect to resemble fire lookout towers out west. This home is also eco-friendly. Run-off water flows into large underground cisterns and then used for irrigation . . .and flushing! This home is also a "tear-down" built on the original house's footprint.
- **5002 Evelyn Byrd Road.** This is a lovely traditional brick Cape Cod home with a fantastic master suite addition on the rear. The interior is decorated "to the nines," and filled with fun and eclectic objects. Be sure to notice the stunning painted credenza in the living room, and the front hallway floor that was hand painted by Susan Cunningham, who lives on Caledonia. The eclectic design continues outside, where you'll meet the chickens residing in their fabulous coop.
- **5013 New Kent Road.** Contemporary meets craftsman in this home that's one of the few ranchers in Westover Hills. The interior is just plain fun! The kitchen now opens into the family room, with plenty of open shelving and a rolling island. You'll love the fabulous painting of the Boulevard Bridge by local artist Steve Hedberg. Be sure and see the interesting, long table in the "world headquarters" room (plates and silverware are painted on the surface). Filled with vintage finds and architectural salvage, this house will make you smile.
- **4911.5 New Kent Road.** You may call it the "Tin Box" or the "Cube," and now you have the opportunity to see what it's all about. The house was designed by a local architect and elevated to fit on an unusual sloping lot. And yes, there's a pool! This is a fun livable house with an open floor plan. Walls of glass offer beautiful views of the woods. One end of the house has a glass "garage door" that rolls up into the ceiling to open the living space to the pool area.
